19th Annual Chess-in-the-Park Rapid Open

Rules and Regulations

<u>Description:</u> This is a six round G/10 individual chess tournament. However, we will do our best to avoid pairing family members and students from the same school. Sections include: Open, Intermediate, Reserve, Novice, Adult/Unrated, & Youth Unrated.

<u>Prizes:</u> Trophies will be given to the top players in each section. The winner of each section will also receive a select chess book. Prizes will also be given to players who correctly answer puzzles in the Puzzler Competition. The Parks Department is giving away event T-shirts to registrants on a first come, first served basis.

<u>YOU MUST:</u> Raise your hand when your game is over to alert your section's TD of the result. **BOTH** players are required to report their result! Please make sure to report your result after your game. <u>Failure to do so may result in forfeiting the rest of your games.</u>

<u>Playoffs:</u> All ties will be determined by Standard USCF Tiebreak Methods – See USCF Rules Note: The Open section will be the only section to have a blitz play-off.

Important reminders for players:

- 1. You have the right to appeal a decision of a floor TD. If you wish to see the Chief TD, tell the floor TD right away. DO NOT wait until after the game is over to make this complaint.
- 2. Clock move at all times. When finished with game, shake hands, report result, reset the chessboard, and leave the playing area.
- 3. The playing area must remain quiet while games are in progress. No talking during play.
- 4. Parents and coaches are spectators. Your help is very important to us, but you may not interfere with the chess games of players, this includes arguing about rulings.
- 5. Illegal moves will result in a loss of 1 minute for each infraction. If a player has less than 1 minute he/she will be forfeited for an illegal move. You cannot capture the King, a King left in check is simply an illegal move.
- 6. All games require a clock. Games without a clock will be marked as a draw. Players can use their smartphones to download a FREE chess clock app and use their phone as a clock with the app if their phone is on airplane mode.

Absolutely no running or play fighting will be tolerated!
