Fund the Creation of a New Online Chess Course for Children

Your gift will fund the development of our new electronic chess course, furthering our reach to more children in New York City and beyond. Creating the online course entails designing a customized online teaching platform, producing engaging teaching videos, building interactive tools, and technical support. Already known as best-in-class in New York, with your help CIS can share our expertise and curriculum to underserved children across the country.

Adopt a School
